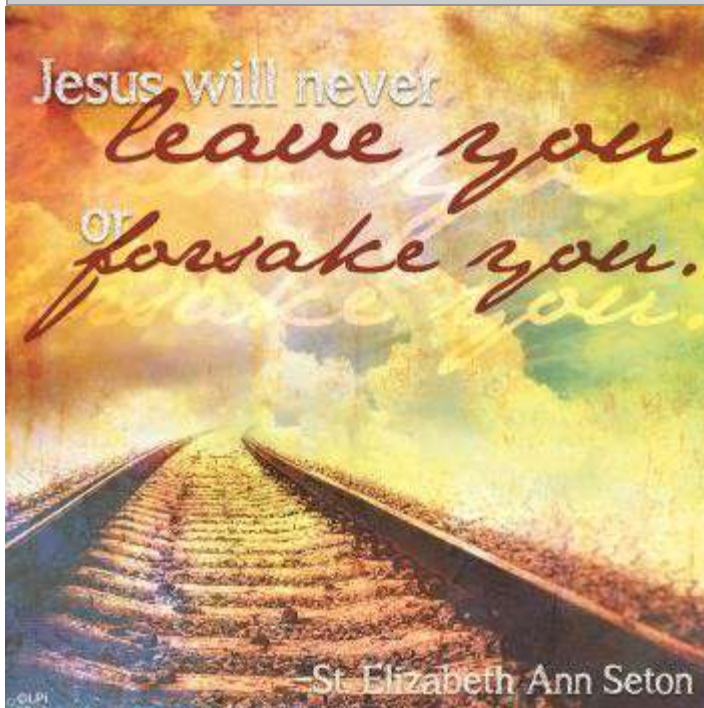

## Deacon Mike's Reflections

A most blessed New Year's greeting to all as we welcome 2019 and pray that this year will be filled with abundant peace and joy. This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany with the Gospel of Matthew. Epiphany means the manifestation of the essential nature of someone or something. In our celebration, it is the manifestation of the divinity of Jesus. We hear the story of the coming of the Magi in their search for the newborn king of the Jews, guided by the light of a star. They are guided by a celestial light to the "light of the universe". It is interesting that foreigners, non believers were some of the first to see and pay homage to the newborn King - the Prince of Peace. They bestow upon him the gifts of gold - honoring his role as King, frankincense - honoring his role as Priest, and myrrh - honoring his ultimate destiny in Jerusalem - his death on a cross and burial. Matthew illustrates that this special child is the fulfillment of the prophets, meant to accomplish marvelous things as the prophet Micah describes "the shepherd of Israel". The example of the Magi share with us that God is not found without leaving the routine and going beyond the normal in our Ordinary lives. We must be persistent as the Magi in our pursuit of the presence of God in our lives. May this New Year and this celebration of the Epiphany bring us to a greater presence of God in our lives and may we share our God given gifts with others to bring that presence alive in their lives.
