## Father Anthony's Reflection

Welcome to this 3rd Sunday of Lent!

In the Gospel reading this Sunday, Jesus speaks to the Samaritan woman and as he searches for her soul, the woman is also able to realize that Jesus is a prophet! 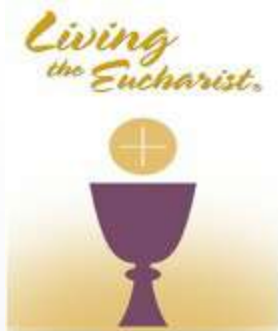

## LITURGY CORNER

"For the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent we celebrate with our RCIA Elect the Scrutinies at the 10:30 Mass. Scrutiny" may sound like an examination of the Elect by the Church, but it's not. The Scrutinies are designed to help them in their final preparation for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. They are meant to:

- Inspire a desire for purification and enlightenment – for examination of self
- Help uncover and then heal all that is weak and sinful in our hearts
- Strengthen all that is upright, strong and good
- Protect from temptation
- Give strength in Christ
- Deliver from the power of sin and Satan

The Scrutiny Rituals include both responsorial Intercessory Prayers for the Elect, and Exorcisms. No, not like the movies! These exorcisms are prayers for the elect by the Priest.

The prayers are designed to:

- Strengthen against sin, doubt and fear
- Protect from Satan and his power
- Help open hearts, acknowledge sin and weakness, confess faults, lay open hidden wounds
- Heal through reliance of Christ.

We do this with the whole community! We are all on this Lenten journey together. We all need to come to a deeper awareness of both the mystery of Sin, from which the whole world longs to be delivered, and the mystery of Christ the Redeemer, who fills believers with living water, light and life everlasting."

### Chrism Mass Bus Trip

There is a bus going to the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart in Richmond for the Chrism Mass on April 6th, at 6pm. The Chrism Mass celebrates the ministry of our diocesan priests, who will concelebrate Mass with Bishop Knestout. Priests are invited to renew their commitment of service during Mass and receive the prayers and support from the faithful in attendance. Bishop Knestout will bless three oils that will be used throughout the diocese in the coming year: the Oil of the Catechumens, used to help those preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation at Easter resist evil; the Oil of the Sick, used to anoint the sick and allow the anointed to experience the saving love of Christ in body and soul; and the Sacred Chrism, or consecrated oil, which is used during the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Ordination of priests, and in the dedication of altars and churches.
